Licensing Update

On December 16, 2016 a draft of the proposed regulations for the *Condominium Management Services Act*, 2015 was released for public consideration and comment.

The public was invited to provide input on the new regulations by February 6, 2017. ACMO struck an ad hoc review committee to provide its recommendations on the proposed regulations.
